Explore Scotland Explore 1,000 miles of stunning coastline and discover islands with spectacular scenery and abundant wildlife. Don't miss Hoy Nature Reserve, where the moorland, cliff tops and the famous Old Man of Hoy rock stack provide the perfect home for diving seabirds such as guillemots and kittiwakes. Take a trip to Brodgar RSPB Reserve to catch sight of curlews, lapwings and even more captivating birdlife.

Popular with outdoor enthusiasts, the islands are a great location for participating in water sports or outdoor adventures. Take to the cliff top trails to view the stunning seascapes, or try diving for your chance to uncover the shipwrecks situated along the coast, such as the remainder of the German naval fleet which was scuttled in Scapa Flow in 1919. Or relax and enjoy gentle coastal walks along serene, sandy shores such as those of Sanday and Stronsay beach.

Steeped in history, explore the prehistoric village of Skara Brae, where you can discover how the people of **Orkney** lived over 5,000 years ago as you view ancient homes fitted with seats, dressers and even beds made of stone. Considered to be the best preserved group of historic houses in Western Europe, Skara Brae makes for a great day out. Visit the fascinating neolithic Ring of Brodgar to uncover an intriguing stone circle thought to have been erected between 2,500BC and 2,000BC. Plus, be sure to discover some of the surprising sights too, such as Europe's oldest standing house, the Knap of Howar on Papa Westray, an impressive 5,500 years old.

With white sandy beaches and turguoise waters, ancient history and intriguing wildlife – the **Outer Hebrides** is a paradise just waiting to be explored. From surfing and windsurfing, to golf and fishing there's plenty to see and do on a day out. 



Escape to Shetland and uncover fascinating ancient history and diverse landscapes amongst an archipelago of over 100 isles. Why not visit the Jarlshof Prehistoric and Norse settlement, one of the most important archaeological sites in Scotland where you can discover 4,000 years of human history. Take a short ferry ride to Mousa Isle, home of the best preserved Broch (iron-age round house) in the world, or take a walk on the magnificent sand tombolo to St. Ninian's Isle, the site of Pictish treasure which was discovered last century.

Discover the beautiful National Nature Reserve of Hermaness in Unst, home to spectacular gannet and puffin colonies who perch on the towering cliffs; and great skuas and red throated divers who nest in the open moorland nearby. The dramatic cliffs of Eshaness form part of Shetland's amazing volcanic trail, and are a great location to spot guillemots and fulmars.

Take a trip to Scalloway Castle, to admire the majesty of this grand castellated mansion overlooking Scalloway's harbour, dating back to 1599 and built by Patrick Stewart, the Earl of Orkney. Then visit the Back Sands Beach near the village of Ollaberry to walk along the massive fault line, part of the Great Glen Fault, which was formed millions of years ago. Climb Ronas Hill, the highest point in Shetland at 450m, to admire fantastic views of the surrounding islands as you keep your eyes peeled for alpine flowers, and even mountain hares as you make your ascent.
