ROUTE DESCRIPTION

Head south to the Clyde Walkway and follow the river bank west on National Cycle Route 75, passing the hulk of the Finnieston Crane which stands in stark contrast to the sleek glass and metal structures of the OVO Hydro and Scottish Event Campus Armadillo, Continue to the Riverside Museum -Glasgow's award winning transport and technology museum - and the Tall Ship Glenlee. Cross the Govan-Partick Swing Bridge and cycle past Govan's historic dry docks and Princes Dock, now home to the Glasgow Science Centre, IMAX Theatre and BBC Scotland.

Recross the river three times, including via the iconic Tradeston 'Squiggly' Bridge, en route to Glasgow Green, the city's oldest park. A circuit of The Green passes notable landmarks such as the Doulton Fountain and The Peoples Palace which is free to enter and well worth a visit, before following the riverbank west, back to the starting point.
