

CALLANDER TO DOUNE & DUNBLANE LOOP (28 MILES, 45 KM)

A circular loop through the breathtaking scenery and history of the Teith Valley

ROUTE DESCRIPTION

Enjoy views of Doune Castle, famous for its appearances in Game of Thrones, Outlander and Monty Python amongst others, on this circular ride from Callander through the Teith Valley.

Pass the historic village of Deanston, before picking up National Cycle Network Route 765 in Doune. This traffic-free path along the former railway line makes for easy cycling towards the town of Dunblane, notable for its spectacular medieval Cathedral and charming Victorian High Street.

Extend your ride to the Wallace Monument by continuing south from Dunblane along Route 765.
