

LOGIERAIT TO DUNKELD LOOP (21 MILES, 33 KM)

A scenic ride along the River Tay to the bustling village of Dunkeld

ROUTE DESCRIPTION

Beginning at Logierait, this leafy loop route follows the banks of the River Tay through the heart of Big Tree Country.

The delightful riverside path takes riders into the historic village of Dunkeld, known as the Gateway to the Highlands. The village's history dates back to the Iron Ages, and a visit to the Cathedral, or a short detour to the nearby Hermitage across Thomas Telford's Dunkeld Bridge, are highly recommended.

Return to Logierait on the Regional Route 83, or climb up from Guay for spectacular views across Tayside and the surrounding hills.
