

GRANTOWN-ON-SPEY LOOP

A challenging but rewarding circuit, exploring Grantown, the 'Forest Village' of Nethy Bridge, and Loch Garten visitscotland.com/cyclingroutes

ROUTE DESCRIPTION

Located on the edge of the spectacular Cairngorms National Park, Grantown-on-Spey makes a great base for exploring the beautiful Strathspey area by bike.

This beautiful circuit takes you on a journey across the River Spey, following scenic B-roads as it links Nethy Bridge, Abernethy Forest and Loch Garten.

Keep your eyes peeled, as the forest is home to a variety of birds and mammals including Scottish crossbill, red squirrel, red deer, black grouse and crested tit. The nearby RSPB Reserve at Loch Garten is also home to nesting Ospreys.
